

Curate Catie's Monthly Musings for April

Dear friends,

Hurray! April is here, and with it come lighter evenings, the lengthening of days and all the signs of spring bursting into life and there's a real sense of renewal and hope, which feels fitting as we journey towards Easter.

In the Church, we are still in Lent, that time of reflection and preparation when we spend time thinking about our relationship with God. Perhaps you gave something up, or taken something on, or simply tried to be more prayerful? Whatever your Lenten journey has looked like, we now start to turn towards Holy Week which is the heart of the Christian story.


