We have been informed that Pye Homes have submitted a planning application to Cotswold District Council, and it is currently being validated to ensure all the required documentation is provided.


Once it has been processed the application will go out for public consultation.

Dear Friends and neighbours

I'm very pleased to be writing this as your new (albeit temporary!) Team Vicar. In reality Lynn Hayler will be continuing her role as Vicar, in practice, of Kempsford & Whelford while I keep a benign eye on things from a distance – six-and-a-half miles, to be precise.

Let me explain. You probably know that our two villages are part of a twenty-one church grouping, the "South Cotswolds Team Ministry". There are ten clergy currently working in the team, some full-time and some part-time; some (like me) with several decades' experience of being a vicar, and others (like Lynn) who are fairly new to the job. When Jean Brown retired from the Meyseys and Castle Eaton last month, it prompted a change in which clergy are responsible for which villages .. and in the process it provided some good news for this parish!

Since the start of last month, Castle Eaton has joined us to make a three-church group, to be the responsibility of a new Team Vicar who will live in Kempsford. We're interviewing this month for the post, and have good hopes that the new vicar will be starting work in the autumn. Meanwhile I've been very pleased to accept the invitation to take formal responsibility for the three churches, alongside my current churches in Coln St Aldwyns and some of its neighbouring villages. In Kempsford and Whelford this will largely mean supporting Lynn Hayler in the excellent work that she's been doing here for the past few months.

Before long Lynn will move on – this is her last year in what has only ever been a short-term training post – and I shall return to the remoteness of Coln St Aldwyns; and you will have a new longer-term, resident, vicar. Until then I look forward very much to getting to know you better and to sharing in the life of the delightful churches here. And whatever changes in their organization and staffing, now and in the future, there is something that never changes – the life-changing love that we find when we open our hearts to the spirit of God, the spirit that we see in Jesus.

Where can you find help to stay warm and well?

This is an information article written by John Read, Chair of Hilary Cottage Surgery Patient Participation Group



Medical practitioners know that staying warm, particularly in winter, can help us all to stay well. Living in a cold damp house can seriously impact health.

Perhaps you know of someone who is in what is termed 'fuel poverty'. It would be surprising if you did not because it is estimated that in Gloucestershire 11% of the population is 'fuel poor'.

What do we mean by this term? Simply it is the inability to pay fuel bills: this results in a cold, damp, unhealthy house. To make do, people will perhaps live in one room and wear extra clothing. Often it is a choice between paying the fuel bill or paying for gas and electricity. Sometimes people are disconnected because they cannot pay their bills.

There is help available for people who find themselves in this situation. The Severn Wye Energy Agency runs a help organisation called **Warm and Well.** They can offer the following **free of charge**

- A free home visit to see how a home can be run more fuel efficiently including installing free energy saving devices such as radiator foils
- A free report detailing savings which can be made
- Free phone calls to give impartial advice
- Tips for saving energy and staying warm
- Information about grants and loans for cavity wall and loft insulation and boiler replacements
- Links to a network of installers and tradespeople
- Switching energy tariffs and suppliers
- Information about smart meters which give accurate bills without having to read a meter and which can help to save energy


Warm and Well find that an average of £400 a year can be saved by following their advice. In addition those people on Pension Credit or low income can get a £140 discount off this winter's gas or electricity bill. If they are pensioners, disabled or suffering from a chronic illness or have a visual or hearing impairment they may be eligible for the Priorities Service Register. This gives access to the following

- Nominated people can help them pay their bills,
- · meters can be moved to an accessible position,
- large print, Braille or talking bills can be provided
- a meter reading service can be provided
- a free annual safety check can be provided
- and priority will be given in an emergency which could include providing alternative heating and cooking facilities in the event of a disconnection
