Curate Catie's Monthly Musings for March

Dear Friends,

March brings with it the changing of the seasons and the beginning of our Lenten journey. It starts with pancake fun on Shrove Tuesday (4th), before preparing ourselves for the solemnity of Ash Wednesday (5th), when we receive the cross in ash on our foreheads, a reminder of our mortality and our need for God's grace: 'Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return.'

Lent is a time of reflection, prayer, and self-examination, inviting us to draw closer to God and we will be holding a Lent Group every Tuesday at 3pm from 11th March to learn about and discuss the meaning of Holy Communion (see Facebook for details nearer the time). Lent isn't just about giving something up, but also about taking something on, whether that is deepening our faith, acts of kindness, or simply creating more space for God in our lives. However you choose to mark this season, may it be one of renewal and blessing.

Midway through Lent, we encounter the joy and thanksgiving of Mothering Sunday (30th). Traditionally, this was a day when people returned to their 'mother church,' but over time it has become a day to celebrate the love and nurture we receive from mothers and mother-figures. It is a day of gratitude but also one of sensitivity, as we remember those who grieve, those who long for children, and those who find this day difficult. As we give thanks, let us hold one another in prayer, lifting up all who share in God's motherly love.

And as we walk through this season together, may we find moments of grace, reflection, and joy. Lent may be a time of challenge, but it is also a path leading us to the hope and light of Easter.

Upcoming Talks Held in The Memorial Hall Lechlade 7pm for 7.30pm

Monday March 17th - Littlecote Roman villa by Dr Hugh Pihlens

The Roman Villa is one of the great treasures of Britain. First discovered in the early 18th century, then covered, forgotten and abandoned 250 years later, in 1976, it was re-discovered. A team of archaeologists worked for 13 years exploring and restoring it, now, renovated again, visitors can enjoy it. Littlecote is an unusual Villa as it covers the whole of the Roman occupation. It houses one of the finest and largest mosaics in Britain

Monday April 14th - Queen Katherine Parr - Gloucestershire's Queen by Mike Bottomley
An integrated live presentation of the extraordinary life of Katherine Parr, the 6th and last wife of King Henry V11. He uses music, readings and video to recreate the atmosphere and intrigues of the Tudor Court to tell the largely unknown storey of the Queen and her journey from obscurity to the heart of English history and on to her final resting place at Sudeley Castle. Step Mother to two Queens, "Bloody Mary" and one of our greatest Queens, Elizabeth 1. She was Queen, Queen Regent, Wife and Lover - Katherine's life storey resonates through the ages
