DOG FOULING

The Parish Council receive more complaints about dog fouling than any other issue, and it was raised again at the recent Annual Parish Meeting.

Two new dog waste bins were purchased last year, but despite this, a few owners are still not using them. In some cases people go to the trouble of using a bag, only to discard it on the grass or in hedges, even in the vicinity of a bin!

Dog fouling is a serious issue. It is unpleasant for other members of the public and grasscutters, and can cause serious illness. One disease, <u>Toxocariasis</u> can cause blindness, especially in children.

Fixed penalties

Under the terms of the Dog Fouling Order, dog mess must be disposed of properly when a dog fouls in a public place.

If dog mess is not picked up and disposed of properly, the District Council's Environmental Wardens can issue a fixed penalty notice for £75 or refer the matter for prosecution in the courts where the fines could be £1000.

Our Environmental Wardens undertake regular patrols to ensure any dog mess or litter is picked up and disposed of properly.

Please do not let a few irresponsible people give the majority of dog owners a bad reputation.

Please report offenders to Cotswold District Council. Complaints will be investigated, offenders will be prosecuted.

It is helpful if you can tell us the time, date and place it happened and the name and address of the person.



The official "Launch" of the Defibrillator has been set for late April. This will be attended by the Gresham Wells Trustees (The Parish Council), the South Western Ambulance Service NHS Foundation Trust (SWASFT), and members of the local Community First Responder group.

Awareness Sessions

Want to know what is in the box and how to use it? The first PAD Awareness Session has been scheduled for 16th May in the Village Hall. A further two will be arranged on a day in June if there is the interest. The sessions will aim to familiarise those attending with what is in the box and how to use it to provide basic life support to a casualty. The sessions will be run by SWASFT with help from local First Responders.

The sessions are open to anyone locally who wants to attend, although it is hoped that local community groups will make every effort to ensure they are represented.



Hilary Cottage Surgery - Patient Participation Group

The Hilary Cottage Patient Participation Group (PPG) is a group of active volunteer patients that work in partnership with the Hilary Cottage Staff and GPs. The group exists to develop a constructive communication between patients, the healthcare team, and the community it serves.

It aims to benefit patients by collecting their opinions and experiences, which the Practice uses to evaluate the delivery of its care. It also provides a means to express concerns and interests ensuring that the practice remains accountable and more proactive in providing services that truly reflect patient needs. The group is not a forum to air individual complaints and issues.

The PPG aims to benefit the Practice by developing a mutually supportive network outside the healthcare team, with whom they can discuss issues that affect the quality of care and the running of the practice. It also aims to communicate to the practice community and/or the wider community information about the practice.

All registered patients are welcome to join the PPG. It is planned to have informal meetings organised by patients every two months and then to meet formally within the Practice three times a year. Community Speed Watch Update

Following concerns raised over the speed of vehicles through the Parish, a Community Speed Watch was recently set up with the support of the Parish Council and Gloucestershire Constabulary, having the aim of reducing vehicle speed by improving drivers awareness, in order to increase public safety.

You may have noticed the team carrying out speed checks in Reevey the week of 13th-19th April.

In all, 9 sessions of 2 hours were carried out where a total of 175 drivers were recorded exceeding the speed limit by more than 20%. Those drivers may be contacted by Gloucestershire constabulary. Drivers should be reminded that the speed limit remains at 30mph leaving Kempsford until the national speed limit signs at the exit to Reevey.

It was felt that generally, overall speeds fell steadily during the week as people became more aware of their speed, therefore the project has been deemed a great success.

We would like to continue with this project and extend to other areas in the parish and would appreciate any volunteers that might like to help out, please contact the Parish Council, full training will be provided.

The team would like to thank residents for their co-operation in this initiative to reduce speed and improve safety.
