#### PARISH COUNCIL NEWS

Thank you to all that attended the Annual Parish Meeting in April. Draft minutes are available to view on the Parish Council Website.

#### Hannington Road Closure

Wales & West Utilities have finally signed all the legal agreements to divert the gas main and scheduled the work to start this month.

Once the gas main has been diverted, Gloucestershire Highways can commence digging out the old culverts and replacing. This work is scheduled to commence on the 28<sup>th</sup> July 2025 and resurfacing will follow. Providing there are no surprises, works will complete around the 19<sup>th</sup> September 2025 and the road will re-open.

#### Whelford to Kempsford Road resurfacing works

The new date for the works will be 15/05/2025 until 30/05/2025 (including Saturday 17th May 2025) and the works will be delivered at night. Night works typically commence at 7pm.

An information letter from Gloucestershire Highways will be sent out to residents with more information shortly.

#### Community Facilities at Hazel View

The Parish Council has been awaiting completion of the Highways agreements before accepting the land transfer from Persimmon Homes. We have now agreed to progress with the transfer to enable the community to begin using the facilities as intended.

A new Management Group is being created in conjunction with the School, to manage the facilities.

#### **Curate Catie's Monthly Musings for May**

Dear friends,

May has arrived and I love it - longer days and the gentle return of warmth to the air.

With the start of a new school term, we hold in prayer our pupils, teachers, and support staff as they set out on a new term of learning, discovery, and friendship. On 8th May, we will be marking an important milestone: the 80th anniversary of VE Day (Victory in Europe) when peace was declared and the war in Europe came to an end in 1945. As we commemorate this anniversary, we honour the courage, sacrifice, and resilience of all those who lived through those dark and demanding years. We remember with gratitude those who served and suffered, and we pray for peace in our own time, especially in places across the world where conflict is tearing lives apart.

This month also gives us space to reflect on some special occasions in the life of the Church and our wider national community.
