IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING FUTURE NEWSLETTERS

Cotswold District Council has announced the closure of their print room. They have printed our Parish Newsletters since the beginning, providing an excellent and very cost effective service.

The cost of printing by external suppliers is over double what we have previously paid and therefore the Parish Council has given considerable thought to how we can continue to produce the monthly newsletter.

Ideally, it would be best if we only printed hard copies for those people who read it and do not have access to online methods of viewing it. Realistically, this is difficult given how the newsletter is distributed by the team of volunteers.

We have decided to try and 'slim-down' the size of the newsletter as a first step, and do this through use of a 'Parish Diary' and better contact details. So, rather than have a full page poster which may only include an event title, date and time, it would appear as a line in the diary. Autumn is definitely upon us, and the weather has turned colder all of a sudden. Today I'm wearing thermals, a thick jumper and hiking socks to work in as my boiler is broken, but many kind people made offers of heaters and hot baths at church yesterday. I've just come back to work after several weeks off sick. Its' been a time of feeling pretty weak and living alone it's been a hard period.

I write this openly because I notice that its' become harder to admit to weakness or loneliness in our society, and harder to ask for help if you don't have family nearby who can come regularly. And yet, more and more people do live alone 30% of households in the UK are now single person households. Loneliness isn't just confined to older people — many young people surveyed recently admitted to feeling lonely and unconnected to others, and finding the period between November and February particularly difficult.

My time at home feeling ill was hard, but it was probably good for me, in that it reminded me of my human frailty and my need to relate to other people. Feeling connected to others is one of the most important factors in good physical and mental health. In winter that becomes harder, and also in this cost-of-living crisis – worrying about money, about the cost of heating, about having enough to eat are all things that can isolate us from one another further, because we are embarrassed. It is hard to ask for help, but we all have times when things are not going well – this is our shared human experience.

It would make a big difference if we could make strong connections with our neighbours and friends over winter — if we could call round for a cuppa or invite someone in, if we had someone we knew we could chat to when the day feels dark and chilly. We all have low days, where energy is in short supply, when a cup of tea and a kind word make all the difference in the world. The village café, the Long Table meal, the community garden, and the church are all places where everyone is welcome and kindness, friendship and tea are freely available. Let's be a village that comes together, and gives and receives that care this autumn and winter.
