What: Temporary Traffic Order to close the road for carriageway resurfacing

Where: 3/168 Horcott Road, Whelford. See overleaf for details of road closure.

When: For approximately 10 Nights (excl. weekends) between the hours of 19:00 to 07:00

The PLANNED start and end dates are currently Thursday 8th October to Wednesday 21st October, however keep an eye on the web page detailed below or the signs on site for any

short notice changes.

Our resurfacing programme is dependent on several factors. It can be affected by things like; heavy rain, changes in temperatures and other weather events as well as plant breakdown and unforeseen technical issues that arise once work has begun. All this means scheme dates and details can change at short notice. We appreciate this is inconvenient, and we will keep our online schedule and our social media feeds updated with more details if changes happen.

ROAD CLOSURE

We will be resurfacing the road at the above location as part of our promise to invest £150 million in the county's roads. To ensure the safety of you and our work force we have, under Sections 14, 15 & 16 of the Road Traffic Act 1984 as amended, made a Temporary Traffic Order to close the road.

Due to the type of engineering activities required with carriageway resurfacing, the road closure can cover an area greater than the area being resurfaced. This is to allow activities, such as movement and placement of machinery and material.

We appreciate road closures are inconvenient, but in order to keep you and the team working on the road safe it is necessary. We have planned the work so we can be in and out as quickly as possible and have tried to do it at a time that will minimise any inconvenience.

ACCESS

In accordance with the Temporary Traffic Order, we are not permitted to allow any person or vehicle to proceed along the closed roads; with the exception of pedestrian access to properties, emergency vehicles, and statutory undertakers responding to an emergency situation.

Therefore, if you normally drive into or out of this area during the hours when the road closure is in place, we ask you to please make alternative arrangements.

In exceptional circumstances, some level of access may be considered. This will be on a case by case basis and only where it doesn't impact on our ability to carry out the work and where it is safe to do so. Any access during this time would be at the drivers own risk as it is a works site and may have raised iron works or a temporary surface.

DIVERSIONS

We have created an official diversion route which will be signposted and is suitable for all vehicles that would normally use the closed road. We appreciate you may know an alternative route, however please be aware alternative routes which are outside of the road closure area are used at driver's discretion.

Road closures - your questions answered

It is often necessary for us to temporarily close a section of road for essential resurfacing or maintenance work. We close the road for safety reasons and also to get the work done as quickly as possible.

You are receiving the following information because you live or work on a section of road that is due to be temporarily closed in the near future. We hope this will help answer any questions you may have. Properties immediately affected by the road closure should have received a letter with further details. If not please contact highways@gloucestershire.gov.uk

Question	Answer
Will we be able to drive back and forth from our property while the road is closed?	As the work involves hot asphalt and large equipment, we will be unable to allow traffic through the Road Closure. If you normally drive into or out of the Road Closure during the hours when the closur is in place, we ask you to please make alternative arrangements. In exceptional circumstances, some level of access may be considered on a case by case basis but only where it does not impact our ability to undertake the necessary works and where it is safe to do so.
Can I walk through the road dosure?	Pedestrian access will be maintained to properties within the road closure and you will be allowed to proceed when it is safe to do so.
Why can't you do these works at night?	We always consider night working as an option but it is often not feasible due to environmental restrictions related to noise, particularly in residential areas.
Where am I expected to park while the road is closed?	If you usually park on the road within the Road Closure, you will need to find alternative parking nearby during the hours of the road closure. There is a possibility that your vehicle may be towed out of the area if it is obstructing the works. Off-Road Parking will not be affected however vehicle access will only be granted in exceptional circumstances where it does not impact our ability to undertake the work and where it is safe to do so.
I'm expecting a delivery to my home during this period — will it get to me?	Delivery drivers are often happy to park nearby and use pedestrian access to make their delivery. Vehicle access through the Road Closure will not be possible, therefore to avoid disappointment please consider rearranging any deliveries for after the work is finished or outside of the road closure hours.
We are a business, how will staff / customers / deliveries be able to get through?	Please encourage staff, customers and deliveries to access the business outside of the Road Closure hours. If this is not possible, please encourage staff and customers to park nearby and use the pedestrian access. In exceptional circumstances, some level of access may be considered on a case by case basis but only where it does not impact our ability to undertake the necessary works and where it is safe to do so.
I'm disabled and need vehicular access to my property – can this be accommodated?	In exceptional circumstances, some level of access can be considered on a case by case basis but only where it does not impact our ability to undertake the necessary works and where it is safe to do so. Please call our Customer Contact Centre with details of your circumstances or, if work is already underway please let our gateman or site manager know your circumstances and they will do what they can to assist.
We are expecting home visits from a carer / district nurse / midwife during this period – will they be able to get through?	Please let your carer / district nurse / midwife know about the road closure as they may need to allow extra time for the visit in case of delays. It is likely that vehicle access through the Road Closure will not be possible, therefore it is suggested that visitors park outside of the road closure and use the pedestrian access. Please call our Customer Contact Centre with details of your circumstances or, if work is already underway, please let our gatemen know of any expected visits in advance and they will do what they can to assist.
This road is on a bus route, what will happen to the buses while the road is closed?	We notify the bus companies about road closures well in advance, they will have arranged alternative routes. Please contact your bus operator for more details.
How will our rubbish and recycling be collected with the road closed?	Your refuse collector will have been advised of the closure well in advance and should have made alternative collection arrangements. Please contact your refuse collector for more details.
Why does the diversion route have to go so far?	Official diversion routes that use roads of an equivalent classification will be signposted. This allows HGV's and buses to be confident that the roads are suitable for them in terms of weight restrictions and low or narrow bridges.
How are you going to stop traffic from using the road past my house? email us at highways@glouc	Official diversion routes will be signposted that use roads of an equivalent classification that are suitable for weighted vehicles such as HGV's and buses. With regards to local traffic movements, we have no authority to stop individual road users from deciding to use alternative routes outside of the road closure.

Dog Fouling

Dog mess is the most unacceptable and offensive type of litter on our streets. It is unpleasant to see it in parks, on the pavement, and especially on your shoe!

While many dog owners are caring, responsible individuals, there are still some people who do not clean up after their pets. Dog fouling is consistently one of the highest sources of complaints by the public to the District Council. Dog fouling is seen as one of the biggest nuisances blighting public spaces. Not only is it an unpleasant sight and smell, its unhygienic and spreads disease.

Dog fouling is not only unpleasant, it is dangerous. Whilst rare, contact with dog excrement can cause toxocariasis. This is an infection caused by the roundworm toxocara canis. The eggs of the parasite can be found in soil or sand contaminated with dog faeces and if swallowed, result in an infection that lasts between 6 and 12 months and can cause blindness. With infected soil samples often found in play areas, toxocariasis most commonly affects children between 18 months and 5 years.

If individuals wish to take action against a dog owner who has not cleaned up after their dog, they should report to the District Council, details of the offence. To include the name and address of the person in charge of the dog, a description of the dog, plus details of the date, time and place.

Cleaning up after your dog is one of the key responsibilities of dog ownership, especially in public places. The best way is to use a doggy bag, or a carrier bag, to pick up the faeces. Ideally this should then be placed in a designated dog bin. However, a lack of a nearby bin is no excuse. To bag it and leave poo bags in trees, on fences or on the ground is also completely unacceptable as this is extremely bad for the environment.

"Dogs and the Law "

The Cotswold District Council Public Spaces Protection Order (PSPO), makes it an offence if you do not remove any poo deposited by your dog. This removal must be done without delay.

Any breach of the Order could result in a £100 fixed penalty notice or being taken to court and receiving a fine on conviction of up to £1000. The PSPO does not apply to blind or partially-sighted people with guide dogs and those with other trained assistance dogs.

LET'S S.C.R.A.P. FLY TIPPING!

We ALL have a DUTY OF CARE, to ensure our household or business waste is disposed of legally and not fly tipped. Avoid an UNLIMITED FINE by following the S.C.R.A.P. code:

- S uspect ALL waste carriers
- C heck with the Environment Agency on 03708 506 506 that the provider taking your waste away is licensed
- R efuse unexpected offers to have waste taken away
- A sk what will happen to your waste
- Paperwork should be obtained get a full receipt



Around two thirds of fly tips are household waste.

These are all examples of fly tipping which YOU could be

fined or prosecuted for.

Did you know?

Under section 34(2A) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990, Domestic Duty of Care, you can be issued a fixed penalty notice of up to £400 if you don't dispose of your waste correctly.

DUTY OF CARE



This includes:

- If fly tipped waste is traced back to YOU
- If YOU failed to make appropriate checks to ensure the transfer of YOUR waste was to an authorised person
- If YOU forget to check if the waste carrier is registered to remove YOUR household waste
- If YOU forget to get a Waste Transfer Note or receipt for the waste which gives a description of the waste, where it was collected from and where it's going

If YOU fail on any of the above, then YOU may receive a fixed penalty notice or face prosecution.


