Though the church buildings remain shut, we as a church are still alive and functioning although in a different way.

In May, Rev Kim Brown will be inducted to serve in the parishes of Castle Eaton, Kempsford with Whelford, Meysey Hampton and Marston Meysey. The graveyards are still open but please use social distancing, ensure that you are careful about using the bins and opening and shutting the gate so as not to spread the infection. You should also be aware that there is no green bin collection at present so no way of disposing of plant wastage.

On the subject of bins. The black bin is for residual rubbish that cannot be recycled and the green bin should only be used for green waste ie no plant pots, cellophane and plastic wrapping or wreaths which have foam and wire in them. Since we are trying to be an ECO church I would also ask you not to use glass containers since they are easily broken by the animals and birds. The church has a small number of tall green plastic containers to be used instead. Contact a church warden if you would like one of these.

Funerals and cremations and the interment of ashes are still taking place but with stringent rules about numbers attending and social distancing.

Rev Canon John Swanton should be informed about any death that occurs in this parish.

If you know of anyone who is experiencing extreme hardship, please make them known, in confidence, to the church wardens. The church does have access to some funds which may be used to help people in need.

The Cotswolds Community Wellbeing Service is a free and confidential service for people aged 16 and above. Our aim is to connect you to local services, organisations and groups that can help improve your general wellbeing and meet your wider social needs.

Who can we help?

Anyone over the age of 16 living in or registered with a Gloucestershire GP in the Cotswolds, can access the Community Wellbeing Service. Referrals can be made by a health or social care professional, a Voluntary and Community Sector Group, members of the community, as well as selfreferral.

The service offers one-to-one support for individuals and also signposting or referrals to activities and groups in their area.

When can we help?

- in times of change, for example after redundancy, health issues or retirement
- in times of emotional hardship, such as after a bereavement
- if you are worried about debt or financial issues
- If you don't know where to turn for support if you would like to volunteer in your community

Garden Waste Bin Collection Suspended by CDC

We have had to suspend the garden waste service. We now have a shortage of staff and no longer have enough experienced drivers available for vehicles on all collection routes. Therefore we are suspending the garden waste service with immediate effect so we can prioritise drivers on the main (statutory) collection services.

All other collections are continuing as normal for the moment.

This reduction has proved necessary given the present unusual pressure on the service caused by the COVID-19 situation and the pressure on staff numbers as a result of self-isolation and other COVID-19 factors and thank you for your understanding.

Additional Advice on Garden Waste

Gloucestershire County Council has already closed the Household Recycling Centres (HRCs) so green waste cannot be taken there.

Please do not put garden waste in the black wheelie bin - excessive wet waste is a problem for the operation of the "Energy from Waste" (Javelin Park Incinerator) plant where all Gloucestershire's black bin waste goes. Garden waste in the black wheelie bin will not be accepted.

What can you do to help at this time?

Increase your home composting and/or reduce the amount of garden waste produced. Lawns are the usual problem - mowing less, planting more wildflower meadow areas, leaving more areas to grow long and only picking up the cuttings every other mow (which lets it dry on the ground before it goes in the compost) all help. If residents don't have a compost heap now would be an excellent time to start one.
